TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for admission to bachelor's degree study (the first degree study programme) is the full completion of secondary education or full secondary vocational education (Higher Education Act, No.131/2002 Coll. as amended). In the case of a foreign applicant or a student who completed secondary education abroad, the education is comparable with an education completed by a school leaving examination in the Slovak Republic. An applicant who completed secondary education abroad will submit along with the application form or more precisely no later than on the date of enrolment the decision on the recognition of the certificate of completion of secondary education recognized by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic.

Other conditions of admission

1. No entrance exams, the Faculty will accept the applicants who meet the following criteria:

- a) applicants from grammar schools who have reached the arithmetic mean of marks at the year-end report for the penultimate year of study (not final year) up to 1.7 inclusive,
- b) applicants from secondary vocational schools, associated schools and academies who have reached the arithmetic mean of marks at the year-end report for the penultimate year of study (not final year) up to 1.5 inclusive,
- c) in the current school year passed NPS (SCIO) tests in general study prerequisites or mathematics and their score was at least 60 percent,
- d) secondary school graduates who during their secondary school study were successful solvers of the Olympiads, Students` Professional Activities (SPA) or international and national competitions related to the content of the study programme and ranked among 1st to 5th place.

Compliance with **one of the conditions mentioned** in **(a)** to **(d)** above is sufficient for admission without entrance exams. Other candidates will have to pass the entrance exams.

2. Entrance exams

Applicants who do not meet the terms and conditions for admission without entrance exams will pass written general knowledge test. The general knowledge test verifies the basic prerequisites and abilities that students need to successfully complete their university study. The test contains a **quantitative part** (simple mathematical tasks, analytical and logical thinking, judgment, inference), a **language part** (ability to analyse the linguistic means of the Slovak language in terms of their grammatical, lexical and stylistic characteristics, meaning and form in vocabulary) and a **general social overview** (orientation in current domestic and foreign events).

Applicants will be admitted on the basis of the results of the admission procedure according to the order of the total number of points achieved, depending on the planned capacity. The final decision about the results of the admission procedure is made by the dean of the Faculty of security Engineering UNIZA on the basis of a proposal of the selection committee of the Faculty. The

Dean is authorised to supplement the state of accepted applicants to the first year of bachelor's degree study programmes to the expected number of applicants who met the conditions for admission to another bachelor's degree study programme but were not accepted due to the capacity of the initially chosen study programme.

In selected bachelor's degree study programmes, in case of vacant places, there is a possibility of organizing a second round of the admission procedure. The list of the bachelor's degree study programmes for the second round of the admission procedure, the deadline for submitting the application form and the date of admission procedure will be published by June 20, 2022. The conditions of admission and the form of the admission procedure for the bachelor's degree study programmes are the same as in the first round of the admission procedure.

Language competence

Written and oral command of the Slovak or Czech language is required for study at the Faculty.



The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable as for the applicants from abroad as for the applicants from Slovakia.

Foreign students who study in a foreign language (i.e. not Slovak), pay the tuition fee as stated in Section 92 (8) of the Higher Education Act. The tuition fee is specified by the UNIZA directive and published for the respective academic year on the university's website. Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the Czech Republic can use the form valid in the Czech Republic to submit their application for study. Applicants who do not actively speak Slovak or Czech are required to successfully complete language training (it is possible to attend the Slovak language courses at UNIZA).

For foreign applicants who were admitted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements or Slovak government grants, terms and conditions stated in respective documents are applicable.



To study in bachelor degree at the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA, one application form where applicants indicate the study programmes in order of their preference is sufficient. In case applicants are interested in both forms of study (full-time and part-time), it is necessary to submit two application forms, including two admission procedure fees.

Applicants fill in the application form - Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 1. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form. The electronic application can be filled in via the UNIZA website: https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php or on the Portal VS (University Portal): https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk/.

Even in the case of an electronic application form, it is necessary to provide the required attachments and proof of payment of the fee. In case of completion of the application form-Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium–1. Stupeň, it is necessary to send it to the address FBI UNIZA, Ul. 1. mája 32, 010 26 Žilina within the stipulated deadlines.

Incomplete application form or application form sent after the deadline will not be accepted.

In case of non-participation in the admission procedure or a failure in the admission procedure, the Faculty does not refund the admission procedure fee.

If the applicant wants to take part in the admission procedure at several faculties of UNIZA, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty with the payment of the relevant fee.

Enclosures for the bachelor's degree application form:

- 1. Curriculum Vitae,
- 2. proof of payment of the admission fee,
- 3. copies of the year-end reports from secondary school.

Upon completion of the school-leaving examination, applicants shall provide a certified copy of the school-leaving examination certificate and the year-end report from the final year of secondary school study by a deadline, which will be announced to each applicant in writing.

BACHELOR'S DEGREE STUDY PROGRAMMES

SECURITY MANAGEMENT

(Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)

The study is focused on the university education of professionals providing security services for tangible or intangible assets of citizens, individuals, legal entities, municipalities and the state from the effects of the security risks and are able to design and operate integrated systems of electronic protection of objects. The graduate acquired knowledge in relevant technical, economic and social sciences and the ability to apply them to the conditions of security management.

CRISIS MANAGEMENT

(Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)


The study is focused on the university education of professionals who are employable in public administration, enterprises and firms in the analysis of risks and potential crisis situations and their monitoring, in the preparation of documents for crisis planning, in the elaboration of crisis plans and management of crises. Graduates have education in the relevant economic, technical and social sciences and in their applications. They can serve in functions in the areas of state defence, civil protection of the population, protection of public order and others.

RESCUE SERVICES

(Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)

The study is focused on the university education of professionals who are able to perform preventive, administrative, rescue and relief activities in the field of fire protection in the structures of state administration, production and economic organizations, in fire and rescue units. They can perform specialized work activities in the performance of state fire supervision, functions in fire-fighting units, fire protection specialists in industrial sectors and departments of the economy of the Slovak Republic.
