TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for admission to bachelor's degree study (the first degree study programme) is the full completion of secondary education or full secondary vocational education (Higher Education Act, No.131/2002 Coll. as amended). In the case of a foreign applicant or a student who completed secondary education abroad, the education is comparable with an education completed by a school leaving examination in the Slovak Republic. An applicant who completed secondary education abroad will submit along with the application form or more precisely no later than on the date of enrolment the decision on the recognition of the certificate of completion of secondary education (nostrification) recognized by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic.

Other conditions of admission

STUDY PROGRAMME - ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE AND CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION

Applicants with an average of study results from secondary school up to 2.0 will be admitted without entrance exams. If they have not reached this average, they will take a knowledge test in the subjects -English language and social studies / civics in the scope of secondary school curriculum. The implementation of the entrance exams is provided by the Department of English Language and Literature and the Department of Philosophy and Religious Studies.

Fulfilment of the conditions for admission to study is assessed by the admission committee, which is appointed by the Dean of the faculty.

STUDY PROGRAMME – MEDIAMATICS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

Applicants with an average of study results from secondary school up to 2.0 will be admitted without entrance exams. If they have not reached this average, they will take a knowledge test in the subjects -Slovak language and literature, social studies / civics and informatics in the scope of secondary school curriculum. The implementation of the entrance exams is provided by the Department of Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage of the Faculty of Humanities UNIZA.

Fulfilment of the conditions for admission to study is assessed by the admission committee, which is appointed by the Dean of the faculty.



ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable as for the applicants from abroad as for the applicants from Slovakia.

Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the Czech Republic can use the form valid in the Czech Republic to submit their application for study. For foreign applicants who were admitted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements or Slovak government grants, terms and conditions stated in respective documents are applicable.



APPLICATION FORM

Application forms are to be submitted for individual study programmes.

In case the applicant is interested in more study programmes, it is necessary to apply for each one individually, including payment of the respective admission procedure fees.

Applicants fill in the application form - Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium-1. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form. The electronic application can be filled in via the UNIZA website: <https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php> or on the Portal VS (University Portal): <https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk//>. In the case of an electronic application, it is necessary to follow the instructions given in the E-application form System.

In case of an incomplete application form, applicants will be requested to complete it.

In case of non-participation in the admission procedure or a failure in the admission procedure, the Faculty does not refund the admission procedure fee. If the applicant wants to participate in the admission procedure at several faculties or UNIZA faculty programmes, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty and programme with the payment of the relevant fee.

Enclosures for the bachelor's degree application form:

- Curriculum Vitae,
- proof of payment of the admission fee,
- copies of the year-end reports from secondary school or more precisely confirmation of study results by secondary school in the application form.

Upon completion of the school-leaving examination, applicants will send a certified copy of the school-leaving examination certificate and the year-end report from the final year of secondary school study by a deadline, which will be announced to each applicant in writing.

Applicants with a completed secondary education will deliver copies of year-end certificates from secondary school and a certified school-leaving examination certificate or they provide a confirmation of the results of the entire secondary school study to the application form by the secondary school.

MEDIAMATICS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

(Field of study 7205 Media and Communication Studies)

Graduates are prepared primarily for study in the master's degree. They are employable in a wide range of public, state, private and non-profit institutions and businesses, memory institutions, media, advertising agencies, information and cultural centres. They can work as information specialists, creators of media content, marketers in the field of cultural heritage for the field of mass media and new communication media.

TEACHING OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE AND CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION

(Field of study 7605 Teaching and Pedagogical Sciences)

Graduates are prepared primarily for study in the master's degree. In rare cases they can work as assistant teachers.
