TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

- The fundamental prerequisite of being accepted to the master's degree study programme (study programme of the second degree) is the full completion of the first degree of the university study (Higher Education Act, n. 131/2002 Coll.).
- Language competence - for study programmes that are carried out by the faculty in the Slovak language, written and oral command of Slovak or Czech language is required. Knowledge of at least one foreign language (English, German, French) is welcome. For study programmes that are carried out by the faculty in the English language, written and oral command of English is required. The applicants who do not actively speak Slovak or Czech are required to attend the language training. It is possible to attend the Slovak language courses at UNIZA. - The faculty retains the right not to open the study programme when the number of applicants is less than 10.
- The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable as for the applicants from abroad as for the applicants from Slovakia.
- Foreign students who study in a foreign language (i.e. not Slovak), pay the tuition fee as stated in § 92 Subsection 8 (Higher Education Act). The tuition fee is specified by the UNIZA directive for the respective academic year, which can be found on the university website. For the academic year 2019/20 the tuition fee is 3500 €.
- Students from abroad who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee.
- For foreign applicants who were accepted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements or Slovak government grants, terms and conditions stated in respective documents are applicable.



FORMS OF ADMISSION

1. No entrance exams (without passing written tests) the Faculty will accept the applicants who:

- have successfully completed their study at the bachelor degree in the same study programme and whose overall weighted average mark is of 2.5 or less and at the same time successfully passed their final state examination on the first attempt.

2. Entrance exams (written tests)

- all the other applicants who do not meet the conditions for being accepted without entrance exams will have to attend the selection procedure (written tests).

Rules of Selection Procedure

Undergraduates of the same or related fields of study may apply for the study. Based on the decision of the guarantor of the relevant second degree study programme, the applicant's application for admission may be rejected if his/her first degree education does not meet the requirements for the bachelor's profile of given study programme.

Applicants will be accepted on the basis of planned capacity of individual study programmes and the evaluation of the applicants, in which the main criterion will be the study results achieved in the bachelor study.

Applicants who have completed their undergraduate studies in related fields may be accepted only on the basis of the results of the written test from the profile subjects according to the chosen field of study. Syllabuses of profile subjects are published on the website of the faculty.

The final decision on the results of entrance exams is made by the Dean of the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA based on the recommendations of the selection committee of the faculty.

In chosen master's degree study programmes, in case of vacant places, there is a possibility of organizing a second round of entrance exams. The list of master's degree study programmes for the second round of entrance exams, the deadline for applying and the date of entrance exams will be announced by July, 11, 2019.

The conditions of admission and the form of admission for master's degree study programmes are the same as in the first round of selection procedure.



HOW TO APPLY

Application forms are to be submitted for individual study programmes.

In case the applicant is interested in more study programmes, it is necessary to apply for each one individually, including payment of the respective admission procedure fees.

Applicants have to fill in the form Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 2. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form that can be found on the university website: <https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php> or on the education portal: <https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk/>.

Even in case of electronic application form, it is required to print it, sign it, enclose other required documents including the proof of payment of the fee and send it to the address FBI UNIZA, Ul. 1. mája 32, 010 26 Žilina within the stipulated deadlines. Incomplete study application or application sent after the deadline will not be accepted.

In the absence or failure of entrance exams, the faculty does not refund the admission fee.

If an applicant wants to take part in entrance exams at more faculties of UNIZA, the application forms have to be sent separately to each faculty and the respective admission procedure fees paid separately to each faculty.

GRADUATE PROSPECTS

MASTER'S STUDY PROGRAMMES

SECURITY MANAGEMENT

(Field of study 8.3.1 Protection of Persons and Property)

The study is aimed at the university education of professionals providing security services for the tangible or intangible assets of citizens, individuals, legal entities, municipalities and the state from the effects of security risks as well as capable of designing and operating integrated electronic security systems for protection of objects. The graduate acquires knowledge in relevant technical, economic and social sciences and the ability to apply them to the terms of security management.

SECURITY AND PROTECTION OF CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

(Field of study 8.3.7 Civil Security)

The study is aimed at the university education of professionals in the field of security and protection of critical infrastructure, with specific focus on energetics, transport and essential fundamentals in the field of information and communication technologies. The graduates are able to design and implement preventive actions, monitor and analyse development of risk-bearing and crisis factors and to prepare an adequate response to the crisis phenomena. They can also manage continuity of operation of critical infrastructure and effectively renew systems in the ex post phase.

CRISIS MANAGEMENT

(Field of study 8.3.7 Civil Security)

The study is aimed at the university education of professionals who can serve in the public sector, enterprises and firms dealing with analysis of the risks and potential crisis situations and their monitoring. They are also able to prepare the documents concerning emergency planning, crisis plans and managing crises. Graduates have a degree in relevant economic, technical and social sciences including their applications. They can serve in functions in the areas of state defence, civil protection of the population, protection of public order and others.

RESCUE SERVICES

(Field of study 8.3.6 Rescue Services)

The study is focused on the university education of professionals who are able to perform preventive, administrative, rescue and relief activities in the field of fire protection in the structures of state administration, production and economic organizations, fire and rescue units. They can perform specialized work activities in the performance of state fire protection, functions in fire-fighting units, fire protection specialists in industrial and economic sectors of the Slovak Republic.
