In case of a small number of applicants, the faculty retains the right not to open the study programme and to offer candidates another study programme in the same or related field of study.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for the admission to the bachelor ´s degree study programme (first degree) is the full completion of secondary education or full secondary vocational education (Higher Education Act, n.131/2002 Coll.). In the case of a foreign applicant or a student who has completed a secondary education abroad, the education is comparable with an education completed by a school leaving examination in the Slovak Republic. Applicant who has completed secondary education abroad will submit along with the application form or more precisely no later than the date of enrolment a document on completion of secondary education recognized by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic.

Other conditions of admission

1. No entrance exams, the Faculty will accept the applicants who meet the following criteria:
 - a) applicants from grammar schools who have reached the arithmetic mean of marks at the year-end report for the penultimate year of study (not final year) up to 1.7 (inclusive),
 - b) applicants from secondary vocational schools, associated schools and academies who have reached the average mean of marks at the year-end report for the penultimate year of study (not final year) up to 1.5 (inclusive),
 - c) in the current school year passed NPS (SCIO) tests in general study prerequisites or mathematics and their score was at least 60 percent,
 - d) secondary school graduates who during their secondary school study were successful solvers of the Olympiads, Students ´ Professional Activities (SPA) or international and national competitions related to the content of the study programme and ranked among 1st to 5th place.

Compliance with **one of the conditions** mentioned in **(a)** to **(d)** above is sufficient for admission without entrance exams. Other candidates will have to pass the entrance exams.

2. Entrance exams

Applicants who do not meet the terms and conditions of admission without entrance exams, will have to take written general knowledge tests. These tests focus on general academic competence that students need to successfully complete their degrees. The test contains **a quantitative part** (simple mathematical tasks, analytical and logical thinking, deduction, drawing conclusion, **a verbal part** (ability to analyse the linguistic means of the Slovak language in terms of their grammatical, lexical and stylistic characteristics, meaning and form in vocabulary) and **a general knowledge overview** (orientation in current domestic and foreign events).

Applicants will be accepted on the basis of the results of entrance exams according to the order of points achieved, depending on the planned capacity. The final decision about the results of entrance exams is made by the dean of FBI UNIZA based on the recommendation of the selection committee of the Faculty. The Dean is authorised to supplement the state of accepted applicants of the first year of bachelor ´s degree study programmes to the expected number of applicants who have met conditions for being accepted for a different bachelor ´s degree study programme but were not accepted due to the full capacity of previously chosen

study programme.

In chosen bachelor´s degree study programmes, in case of vacant places, there is a possibility of organizing a second round of entrance exams. The list of the bachelor´s degree study programmes for the second round of entrance exams, deadline for applying and the date of entrance exams will be announced by 19.6.2020. The terms of admission and the form of admission for the bachelor´s degree study programmes are the same as in the first round.

3. Written and oral command of Slovak language or Czech language is required for study at the Faculty.



ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable as for the applicants from abroad as for the applicants from Slovakia.

Foreign students who study in a foreign language (i.e. not Slovak), pay the tuition fee as stated in § 92 Subsection 8 (Higher Education Act). The tuition fee is specified by the UNIZA directive for the respective academic year, which can be found on the university website. Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the Czech Republic who want to apply and study in Žilina can use the application form valid in the Czech Republic. Applicants who do not actively speak Slovak or Czech are required to attend the language training (it is possible to attend the Slovak language courses at UNIZA). For foreign applicants who were accepted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements or Slovak government grants, terms and conditions stated in respective documents are applicable.



APPLICATION FORM

To apply for any of the bachelor´s degree study programmes at the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA, one application form where applicants indicate the study programmes in order of their preference is satisfactory. In case applicants are interested in both forms of study (full time and part time), it is necessary to apply for both of them (two application forms are required), including the two admission procedure fees.

Applicants have to fill in the form *Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 1. Stupeň* or they can also use an electronic application form that can be found on the university website: <https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php> or on the education portal: <https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk/>.

Even in case of electronic application form, it is required to print it, sign it, enclose other required documents including the proof of payment of the fee and send it to the address FBI UNIZA, Ul. 1. mája 32, 010 26 Žilina within the stipulated deadlines. In case of incomplete application form, applicants will be requested to complete it.

In the absence or a failure of entrance exams, the Faculty does not refund the admission fee.

If the applicant wants to take part in entrance exams at several faculties of UNIZA, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty and the respective admission procedure fees paid separately to each faculty.

Enclosures for the bachelor´s degree study programmes (to be sent with application forms):

1. Curriculum Vitae,
2. proof of payment of the admission fee,
3. copies of the year-end reports from secondary school.

Upon completion of the school-leaving examination, applicants shall provide a certified copy of the school-leaving examination certificate and the year-end report from the final year of secondary school study to date, which will be announced to each applicant in writing.

After completing the bachelor's degree, it is necessary to verify the current state of the offer of study programmes in a particular academic year.



GRADUATE PROSPECTS

BACHELOR'S DEGREE STUDY PROGRAMMES

SECURITY MANAGEMENT

(Field of study Safety and Security Sciences)

The study is aimed at the university education of professionals providing security services for the tangible or intangible assets of citizens, individuals, legal entities, municipalities and the state from the effects of security risks as well as capable of designing and operating integrated electronic security systems for protection of objects. The graduate has acquired knowledge in relevant technical, economic and social sciences and the ability to apply them to the terms of security management.

SECURITY AND PROTECTION OF CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

(Field of study Safety and Security Sciences)

The study programme prepares experts in the field of security and protection of critical infrastructure, with specific focus on energetics, transport and essential fundamentals in the field of information and communication technologies. Graduates are able to design and implement preventive actions, monitor and analyse development of risk-bearing and crisis factors and to prepare an adequate response to the crisis phenomena. They can also manage the continuity of operation of critical infrastructure and effectively renew systems in the ex post phase.

CRISIS MANAGEMENT

(Field of study Safety and Security Sciences)

The study is aimed at the university education of professionals who can serve in the public sector, enterprises and firms dealing with analysis of the risks and potential crisis situations and their monitoring. They are also able to prepare the documents concerning emergency planning, crisis plans and managing crises. Graduates have a degree in relevant economic, technical and social sciences including their applications. They can serve in functions in the areas of state defence, civil protection of the population, protection of public order and others.

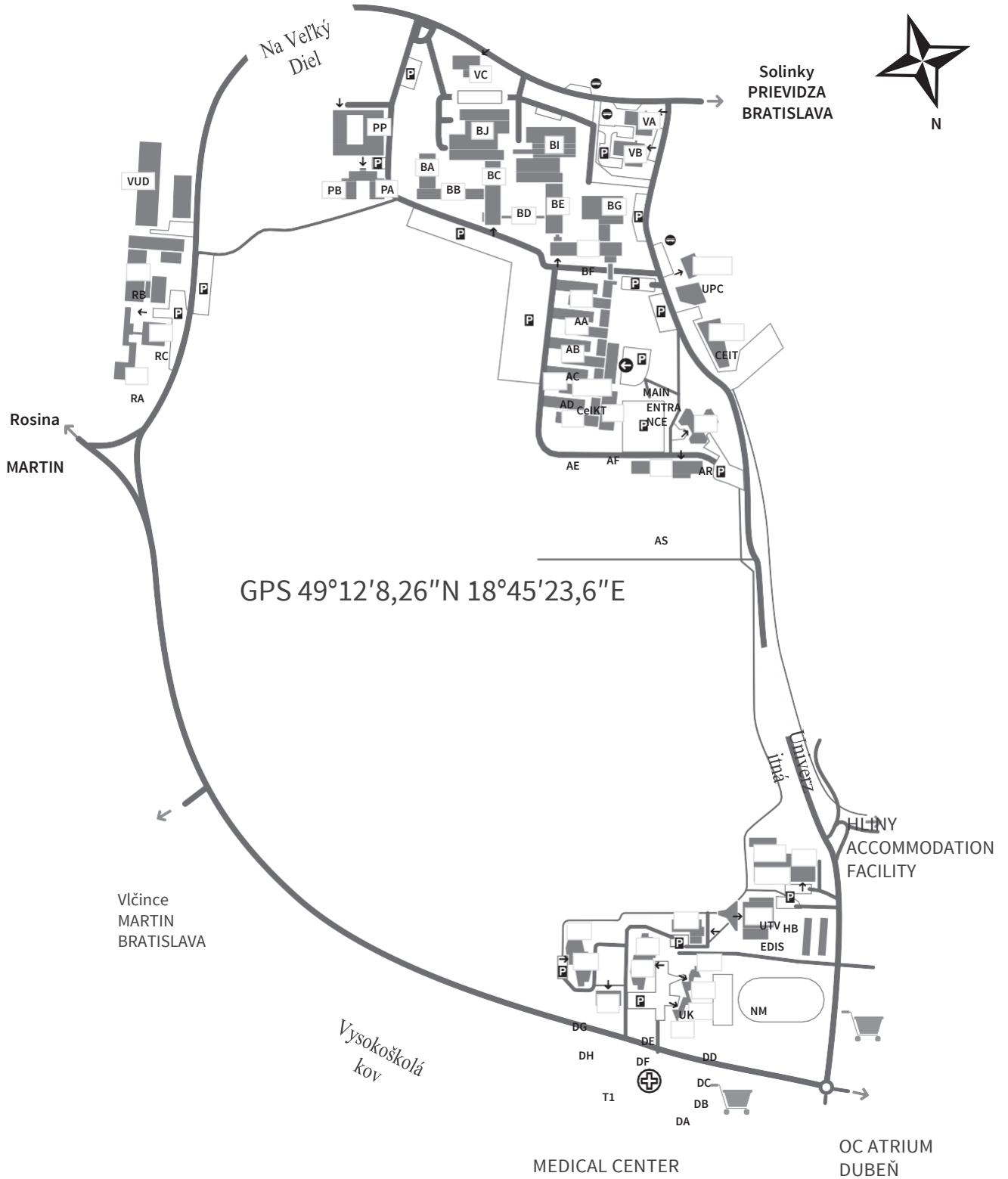
RESCUE SERVICES

(Field of study Safety and Security Sciences)

The study is focused on the university education of professionals who are able to perform preventive, administrative, rescue and relief activities in the field of fire protection in the structures of state administration, production and economic organizations, fire and rescue units. They can perform specialized work activities in the performance of state fire protection, functions in fire-fighting units, fire protection specialists in industrial and economic sectors of the Slovak Republic.
