In case of a low number of applicants for full-time and part-time study, the faculty retains the right not to open a study programme and to offer applicants another study programme in the same or related field of study.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for admission to master's (engineering) degree study (study programme of the second degree) is the full completion of the first degree of university study (Higher Education Act, no. 131/2002 Coll.) in the same or related field of study. In case of a foreign applicant or a student who has completed his / her study abroad, he / she shall submit along with the application form (no later than the date of enrolment) a decision on the recognition of the certificate of completion of the first degree of higher education recognized by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic or he / she shall ask UNIZA for the recognition of the certificate of education.

Other conditions of admission

1. No entrance exams, the Faculty will accept Bachelor's degree graduates who:

To the master's (engineer) degree study programmes, the Faculty will accept the bachelor's degree graduates in the same study programme who achieved in bachelor's degree study programme an overall weighted average of marks 2.5 or less and at the same time successfully passed their final state examination on the first attempt. Other applicants will have to pass entrance exams.

2. Admission Procedure - Entrance Exams:

All the other applicants who do not meet the conditions for being accepted without entrance exams will have to attend the selection procedure (with written test).

Rules of Admission Procedure

Bachelor's degree graduate of the same or related field of study may apply for the study. Based on the decision of the guarantor of the relevant second degree study programme, the applicant's application for admission may be rejected if his/her higher education of the first degree does not meet the requirements for the bachelor's profile of given field of study.

Applicants will be accepted on the basis of planned capacity of individual study programmes and the evaluation of applicants, in which the main criterion will be the study results achieved in the bachelor study.

Applicants who have completed the first degree of higher education in one of the related fields of study may be admitted only on the basis of the results of the written test from profile subjects of the selected study programme. The theses of profile subjects are published on the website of the Faculty.

The final decision on the results of entrance exams is made by the Dean of the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA based on the recommendations of the selection committee of the Faculty.



ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable as for the applicants from abroad as for the applicants from Slovakia.

Foreign students who study in a foreign language (i.e. not Slovak), pay the tuition fee as stated in § 92 Subsection 8 (Higher Education Act). The tuition fee is specified by the UNIZA directive and published for the respective academic year on the university website. Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the

Czech Republic who want to apply and study at UNIZA can use the application form valid in the Czech Republic. Applicants who do not actively speak Slovak or Czech are required to attend the language training (it is possible to attend the Slovak language courses at UNIZA). For foreign applicants who were accepted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements or Slovak government grants, terms and conditions stated in respective documents are applicable.



APPLICATION FORM

Application forms are to be submitted for individual study programmes.

In case the applicant is interested in more study programmes, it is necessary to apply for each one individually, including payment of the respective admission procedure fees.

Applicants have to fill in the form Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 2. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form that can be found on the university website: <https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php> or on the education portal: <https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk/>.

Even in case of electronic application form, it is required to print it, sign it, enclose other required documents including the proof of payment of the fee and send it to the address FBI UNIZA, Ul. 1. mája 32, 010 26 Žilina within the stipulated deadlines.

In case of incomplete application form, applicants will be requested to complete it.

In case of absence or failure of entrance exams, the Faculty does not refund the admission fee.

If the applicant wants to take part in entrance exams at several faculties of UNIZA, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty and the respective admission procedure fees paid separately to each faculty.

GRADUATE PROSPECTS

MASTER'S (ENGINEER) DEGREE STUDY PROGRAMMES

SECURITY MANAGEMENT

(FIELD OF STUDY – SECURITY SCIENCES)

The study is focused on higher education of professionals providing security services for tangible or intangible assets of citizens, individuals, legal entities, municipalities and the state from the effects of security risks as well as capable of designing and operating integrated electronic security systems for protection of objects. Graduates acquired knowledge in relevant technical, economic and social sciences and the ability to apply them to the conditions of security management.

SECURITY AND PROTECTION OF CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

(Field of study – Security Sciences)

The study is focused on higher education of professionals in the field of security and protection of critical infrastructure with an emphasis on energy, transport and fundamentals in the field of information and communication technologies. Graduates are able to design and implement preventive actions, to monitor and analyse development of risk-bearing and crisis factors and to prepare an adequate response to the crisis phenomena. They can also manage the continuity of operation of critical infrastructure and effectively renew systems.

CRISIS MANAGEMENT

(Field of study – Security Sciences)

The study is focused on higher education of professionals who can serve in the public sector, enterprises and firms dealing with analysis of the risks and potential crisis situations and their monitoring. They are also able to prepare the documents concerning emergency planning, crisis plans and managing crises. Graduates have an education in relevant economic, technical and social sciences including their applications. They are employable in positions in the areas of state defence, civil protection of the population, protection of public order and others.

RESCUE SERVICES

(Field of study – Security Sciences)

The study is focused on higher education of professionals who are able to perform preventive, administrative, rescue and relief activities in the field of fire protection in structures of state administration, production and economic organizations, fire and rescue units. They can perform specialized work activities in the performance of state fire protection, functions in fire-fighting units, fire protection specialists in industrial and economic sectors of the Slovak Republic.
