In case of a low number of applicants for full-time and part-time study, the faculty retains the right not to open a study programme and to offer the applicants another study programme in the same or related field of study.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for admission to master's (engineering) degree study (study programme of the second degree) is the full completion of the first degree of university study (Higher Education Act, no. 131/2002 Coll.). In case of a foreign applicant or a student who has completed his / her study abroad, he / she shall submit along with the application form (no later than the date of enrolment) a decision on the recognition of the certificate of completion of the first degree of higher education recognized by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic or he / she shall ask UNIZA for the recognition of the certificate of education.

Other conditions of admission

1. No entrance exams

Bachelor's degree graduates in the same study programme who achieved in bachelor's degree study programme an overall weighted average of marks 2.5 or less and at the same time successfully passed their final state examination on the first attempt. Other applicants will have to pass entrance exams.

2. Admission Procedure - Entrance Exams

All the other applicants who do not meet the conditions for being accepted without entrance exams will have to attend the selection procedure (with written test).

Rules of Admission Procedure

Bachelor's degree graduate may apply for the study. Based on the decision of the guarantor of the relevant second degree study programme, the applicant's application for admission may be rejected if his/her higher education of the first degree does not meet the requirements for the bachelor's profile of the given field of study.

Applicants will be accepted on the basis of the planned capacity of individual study programmes and the evaluation of applicants, in which the main criterion will be the study results achieved in the bachelor's degree study.

Applicants who have completed the first degree of university study at another university or faculty may be admitted only on the basis of the results of a written test from profile subjects of the selected study programme. The theses of profile subjects are published on the website of the Faculty.

The final decision on the results of entrance exams is made by the Dean of the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA based on the recommendations of the admission committee of the Faculty.



ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable as for the applicants from abroad as for the applicants from Slovakia.

Foreign students who study in a foreign language (i.e. not Slovak), pay the tuition fee as stated in § 92 Subsection 8 (Higher Education Act). The tuition fee is specified by the UNIZA directive and published for the respective academic year on the

university website. Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the Czech Republic who want to apply and study at UNIZA can use the application form valid in the Czech Republic. Applicants who do not actively speak Slovak or Czech are required to attend the language training (it is possible to attend the Slovak language courses at UNIZA). For foreign applicants who were accepted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements or Slovak government grants, terms and conditions stated in respective documents are applicable.



Application forms are to be submitted for individual study programmes.

Applicants have to fill in the form Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 2. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form that can be found on the university website: https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php or on the education portal: https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk/.

Even in case of electronic application form, it is required to print it, sign it, enclose other required documents including the proof of payment of the fee and send it to the address FBI UNIZA, Ul. 1. mája 32, 010 26 Žilina within the stipulated deadlines. In case of incomplete application form, applicants will be requested to complete it.

In case of non-participation in the admission procedure or a failure in the admission procedure, the Faculty does not refund the admission procedure fee.

If the applicant wants to participate in the admission procedure at several faculties of UNIZA, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty with payment of the relevant fee.

There is a possibility of extended studies within follow-up doctoral degree study programmes at the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA in the academic year 2021/2022 – Security management, Crisis Management, Rescue Services (respective information about particular study programmes can be found on the university website). After completing the master's (engineering) degree, it is necessary to verify the current state of the offer of study programmes in a particular academic year.



MASTER'S (ENGINEERING) DEGREE STUDY PROGRAMMES

SECURITY MANAGEMENT

(Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)

The study is focused on the university education of professionals providing security services for tangible or intangible assets of citizens, individuals, legal entities, municipalities and the state from the effects of the security risks. They are also able to design and operate the integrated systems of electronic protection of objects. Graduates acquired knowledge in relevant technical, economic and social sciences and the ability to apply them to the conditions of security management.

SECURITY AND PROTECTION OF CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE (Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)

The study is focused on the university education of professionals in the field of critical infrastructure protection with an emphasis on energy, transport and fundamentals in the field of information and communication technologies. Graduates are able to design and implement preventive measures, monitor and analyse the development of risk and crisis factors and prepare an adequate response to the emerging crisis phenomenon. They can also manage the continuity of operation of critical infrastructure and effectively renew systems.

CRISIS MANAGEMENT

(Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)

The study is focused on the university education of professionals who are employable in public administration, enterprises and firms in the analysis of risks and potential crisis situations and their monitoring. They are able to prepare materials for crisis planning, elaboration of crisis plans and crisis management. Graduates have education in the relevant economic, technical and social sciences and in their applications. They can serve in functions in the areas of state defence, civil protection of the population, protection of public order and others.

RESCUE SERVICES

(Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)

The study is focused on the university education of professionals who are able to perform preventive, administrative, rescue and relief activities in the field of fire protection in the structures of state administration, production and economic organizations, in fire and rescue units. They can perform specialized work activities in the performance of state fire supervision, functions in fire-fighting units, fire protection specialists in industrial sectors and departments of the economy of the Slovak Republic.
