TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for admission to doctoral degree study (study programme of the third degree) is the full completion of the second degree of university study (Higher Education Act, no. 131/2002 Coll.). In case of a foreign applicant or a student who has completed his / her study abroad, he / she shall submit along with the application form (no later than the date of enrolment) a decision on the recognition of the certificate of completion of the second degree of university study recognized by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic or he / she shall ask UNIZA for the recognition of the certificate of education.

Other conditions of admission

Admission Procedure

The selection of applicants will be based on the evaluation of the entrance exams. The entrance exam is carried out in the form of an oral examination in front of the committee of the relevant field of study. Content of the exam is to verify the knowledge of foreign language, mathematics and professional and scientific orientation of the applicant in the field he / she applies for, including the reasons for choosing the topic, methods which he / she expects to use in solving the topic as well as the expected conclusions of the thesis. The evaluation includes the assessment of the results of previous study and the prerequisites for independent scientific work of applicant.

Rules of Admission Procedure

The course of the entrance exam is regulated by UNIZA Directive no. 110, as amended by Amendment no. 1 Study Regulations for the Third Degree of University Study at the University of Žilina in Žilina.

The Admission Committee submits the results of the admission procedure as well as their proposal for admission of successful applicants to the Dean of the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA. The Dean of the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA, after discussing the proposal with the Committee and the guarantors of the doctoral degree study programmes and on the basis of capacity, will decide on the admission / rejection of the applicant within 30 days from the date of the entrance exam.



ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable as for the applicants from abroad as for the applicants from Slovakia.

Foreign students who study in a foreign language (i.e. not Slovak), pay the tuition fee as stated in § 92 Subsection 8 (Higher Education Act). The tuition fee is specified by the UNIZA directive and published for the respective academic year on the university website. Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the Czech Republic who want to apply and study at UNIZA can use the application form valid in the Czech Republic. Applicants who do not actively speak Slovak or Czech are required to attend the language training (it is possible to attend the Slovak language courses at UNIZA). For foreign applicants who were accepted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements or Slovak government grants, terms and conditions stated in respective documents are applicable.



APPLICATION FORM

Application forms are to be submitted for individual study programmes.

In case the applicant is interested in more study programmes, it is necessary to apply for each one individually, including the payment of the respective admission procedure fees.

Applicants have to fill in the form Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 3. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form that can be found on the university website: <https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php> or on the education portal: [https:// prihlaskavs.sk/sk/](https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk/).

Even in case of electronic application form, it is required to print it, sign it, enclose other required documents including the proof of payment of the fee and send it to the address of the Faculty of Security Engineering UNIZA, Ul. 1. mája 32, 010 26 Žilina within the stipulated deadlines.

Incomplete application form or the application form sent after the deadline will not be accepted.

In case of non-participation in the admission procedure or a failure in the admission procedure, the Faculty does not refund the admission procedure fee. If the applicant wants to take part in the admission procedure at several faculties of UNIZA, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty with the payment of the relevant fee.

Enclosures for the doctoral degree study programmes (to be sent with application form):

- Curriculum Vitae,
- certified copies of the highest level of education completed (Diploma on completion of university education of the 2nd degree, certificate on state examination, Diploma Supplement),
- certified copy of the certificate of state examination from foreign language (if the applicant passed the examination),
- list of published professional and scientific papers (in case the applicant has published so far),
- other evidence indicating any professional activities,
- the original proof of payment of administrative fee for the admission procedure,
- the intention of solving the selected dissertation topic (topic name, applicant, supervisor, reasons for the selection of the topic, hypotheses and methods of solution, expected results and benefits of the solution, ...),
- a document from the Ministry of Education, Science, Research and Sport of the Slovak Republic on the recognition of university education of the 2nd degree completed outside the Slovak Republic (applies to foreign and Slovak candidates who have graduated from a university of the 2nd degree abroad, including the Czech Republic).

DOCTORAL STUDY PROGRAMMES

SECURITY MANAGEMENT

(FIELD OF STUDY 9205 SECURITY SCIENCES)

Graduates of the third degree of university study of the study programme Security Management master the scientific methods and approaches in the field of protection of persons and property, research and evaluation of various impacts on the overall level of security of persons and property. They do scientific research and bring new approaches in order to ensure the protection of persons and property. On the basis of scientific methods of knowledge and research, they are able to design conceptual and system solutions for the protection of persons and property. They apply a systematic approach when solving tasks of security practice.

CRISIS MANAGEMENT

(Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)

Graduates of the third degree of university study of the study programme Crisis Management master the scientific methods and tools used in the analysis of risks and threats of security of specific subjects, regions or the whole country. They are able to use analytical methods to optimise processes and design complex measures to increase the security of systems. They are also able to design new methods and technologies for dealing with crisis events.

RESCUE SERVICES

(Field of study 9205 Security Sciences)

Graduates of the third degree of university study of the study programme Rescue Services master the scientific methods of research and development in the field of rescue activities and in the field of fire protection. Based on scientific methods, they can create programmes for long-term development of an integrated rescue system. They are able to use analytical methods of process optimization and design complex measures in order to improve the quality of operation of the integrated rescue system. They design new methods and technologies for carrying out rescue operations.
