TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for the admission to the bachelor´s degree study programme (first degree) is the full completion of secondary education or full secondary vocational education (Higher Education Act, n.131/2002 Coll.). In the case of a foreign applicant or a student who has completed secondary education abroad, the education is comparable with an education completed by a school leaving examination in the Slovak Republic. Applicant who has completed secondary education abroad will submit along with the application form or more precisely no later than the date of enrolment a document on completion of secondary education recognized by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic.

Other conditions of admission

STUDY PROGRAMME - ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE AND CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION

In combinations with the English language, preference will be given to applicants who in the state school-leaving examination succeeded in the external part at level B2 and achieved at least 60% and at level B1 at least 75%. The study results from secondary school with an emphasis on the subjects that applicant wants to study; results from subjects that form the basis of selected study programmes; participation or results from national and international rounds of Olympiads, Students` Professional Activities (SPA), state examinations and certificates in foreign languages are also important. In case of equal number of points, the overall study average is also a decisive factor. The results of the external school leaving examination will be multiplied by the coefficients as follows: Level B2 (and all substitutions of school leaving examination, e.g. FCE certificate, state language examination, etc.): 2 x % that the student achieved in the examination.

STUDY PROGRAMME - MEDIAMATICS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

Applicants with an average of study results from secondary school up to 2.0 will be admitted without entrance exams. If they have not reached this average, they will take a knowledge test in the subjects Slovak language and literature, social studies / civics and informatics in the scope of secondary school curriculum. The implementation of the entrance exams is provided by the Department of Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage of the Faculty of Humanities UNIZA.

STUDY PROGRAMME - SOCIAL PEDAGOGY

Entrance exams will be carried out in writing in the form of a knowledge test from a general overview of the social studies in the scope of grammar school curriculum. Graduates of grammar schools who have graduated from the subject of social studies and the average of this subject on annual certificates and at the school leaving examination is not worse than 1.5 will be waived the test from the general overview of social studies. Graduates of social and pedagogical academies, whose average in the subject of pedagogy on annual certificates and in the theoretical part of the professional component of the school leaving examination is not worse than 1.5, will be waived the test from the general overview of social studies.

STUDY PROGRAMME - CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION

In the study programme Citizenship Education, applicants will be admitted without entrance exams. When assessing applicants, the study results from the secondary school with an emphasis on the subjects that the applicant wants to study and the results from the subjects that form the basis of the selected study programmes are important.



ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable as for the applicants from abroad as for the applicants from Slovakia.

Foreign students who study in a foreign language (i.e. not Slovak), pay the tuition fee as stated in § 92 Subsection 8 (Higher Education Act). The tuition fee is specified by the UNIZA directive and published for the respective academic year on the university's website. Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the Czech Republic who want to apply and study in Žilina can use the application form valid in the Czech Republic. For foreign applicants who were accepted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements or Slovak government grants, terms and conditions stated in respective documents are applicable.



APPLICATION FORM

Application forms are to be submitted for individual study programmes.

In case the applicant is interested in more study programmes, it is necessary to apply for each one individually, including payment of the respective admission procedure fees.

Applicants have to fill in the form Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 1. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form that can be found on the university website: https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php or on the education portal: https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk/. In the case of an electronic application, it is necessary to follow the instructions given in the E-application form System.

In case of incomplete application form, applicants will be requested to complete it.

In case of non-participation in the admission procedure or a failure in the admission procedure, the Faculty does not refund the admission procedure fee.

If the applicant wants to take part in the admission procedure at several faculties of UNIZA, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty with the payment of the relevant fee.

Enclosures for the bachelor's degree study programmes (to be sent with application form):

- Curriculum Vitae,
- proof of payment of the admission fee,
- copies of the year-end reports from secondary school or more precisely confirmation of study results by secondary school in the application form.

Upon completion of the school-leaving examination, applicants shall provide a certified copy of the school-leaving examination certificate and the year-end report from the final year of secondary school study by a deadline, which will be announced to each applicant in writing.

ACCOMMODATION

BACHELOR'S DEGREE STUDY PROGRAMMES

MEDIAMATICS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

(Field of study 7205 Media and Communication Studies)

Graduates are prepared primarily for study in the master's degree. They are employable in a wide range of public, state, private and non-profit institutions and businesses, memory institutions, media, advertising agencies, information and cultural centres. They can work as information specialists, creators of media content, marketers in the field of cultural heritage for the field of mass media and new communication media.

SOCIAL PEDAGOGY

(Field of study 7605 Teaching and Pedagogical Sciences)

Graduates of the field of study Teaching and Pedagogical Sciences (1st degree) will acquire a professional competence to work as social pedagogues, professional educators and leisure time pedagogues. They are capable of carrying out professional activity as social pedagogues in social services. They are also employable in the field of public social administration as employees of state administration and self-government in the field of child and youth care, as social pedagogues in state, private or non-governmental organizations with a focus on community support of education and training. Furthermore, they can work as educators in in the field extracurricular education and out-of-school education and as organizers of non-formal education.

TEACHING OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE AND CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION (Field of study 7605 Teaching and Pedagogical Sciences)

Graduates are prepared primarily for study in the master's degree. In rare cases they can work as assistant teachers.
