TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Basic condition of admission

The basic condition for admission to the bachelor's degree study (the first-degree study programme) is the full completion of secondary education or full secondary vocational education (Higher Education Act No. 131/2002 Coll. as amended). In the case of a foreign applicant or a student who completed secondary education abroad, the education is comparable to that completed by a school leaving examination in the Slovak Republic. An applicant who completed secondary education abroad shall submit, along with the application form or, more precisely, no later than on the date of enrolment, a decision on the recognition (nostrification) of the certificate of completion of secondary education recognised by a relevant institution in the Slovak Republic.

The foreign applicant shall submit a certificate of the required language level B1, according to the European Framework of Reference for Languages, in the Slovak language. If he/she does not have such a certificate, he/she will take a test to determine the above-mentioned required level of Slovak language proficiency on the date of the entrance examination.

Other conditions of admission

1. Applicants with a secondary school grade point average of up to 2.0 will be admitted without an entrance exam (the average includes grades from the first three years of secondary school, not from the last year and the results of the school-leaving examination).

2. Entrance exam

If they have not achieved an average grade of 2.0 in secondary school, they will take a knowledge test in Slovak language and literature, social studies/civics, and informatics in the scope of the secondary school curriculum. The entrance exam is administered by the Institute of Mediamatics and Cultural Heritage. The admission committee appointed by the director of the institute evaluates whether the conditions for admission to the programme have been met.



ADMISSION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS

The basic and other terms and conditions of admission are applicable for applicants from abroad as well as for applicants from Slovakia. Foreign students who study in the Slovak language do not have to pay the tuition fee. Applicants from the Czech Republic can use the form valid in the Czech Republic to submit the application for study. For foreign applicants who were accepted on the basis of intergovernmental agreements, bilateral agreements, or Slovak government grants, the terms and conditions stated in the respective documents are applicable.



APPLICATION FORM

Application forms are to be submitted for individual study programmes.

In case the applicant is interested in more study programmes, it is necessary to apply for each one individually, including payment of the respective admission procedure fees.

Applicants fill in the application form - Prihláška na vysokoškolské štúdium - 1. Stupeň or they can also use an electronic application form. The electronic application can be filled in via the UNIZA website: <https://vzdelavanie.uniza.sk/prijimacky/index.php> or on the Portal VS (University Portal): <https://prihlaskavs.sk/sk/>. In the case of an electronic application, it is necessary to follow the instructions given in the E-application form System.

In case of the incomplete application form, applicants will be requested to complete it.

In case of non-participation in the admission procedure or a failure in the admission procedure, the institute does not refund the admission procedure fee. If the applicant wants to participate in the admission procedure at several faculties or UNIZA faculty programmes, the application forms must be submitted separately to each faculty and programme with the payment of the relevant fee.

Attachments to the bachelor's degree application form:

- curriculum vitae,
- proof of payment of the admission fee,
- copies of the year-end reports from secondary school or more precisely confirmation of study results by secondary school in the application form. Upon completion of the school-leaving examination, applicants will send a certified copy of the school-leaving examination certificate and the year-end report from the final year of secondary school study by a deadline, which will be announced to each applicant in writing.

Applicants with a completed secondary education will deliver copies of year-end certificates from secondary school and a certified school-leaving examination certificate or they provide a confirmation of the results of the entire secondary school study to the application form by the secondary school.
